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I have attached the Saginaw Police Department's 2015 Racial Profiling Report, as required under Section 2.132 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure (CCP). I certify that the department has met all requirements imposed by code.

As you know, state law prohibits peace officers from engaging in the practice of racial profiling. Law enforcement agencies are also required to collect specific data on traffic stops, and report that data to the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) and their governing body on an annual basis. The TCOLE report is due no later than March 1 of each year. While no timetable is established for council reporting, we traditionally do so in late February or early March.

The attached report indicates that the department claims partial exemption in reporting, since we regularly capture traffic stops on video camera. Videos are then stored for a minimum of 90 days, as required by Section 2.13(a) of the CCP. Current technology allows us to store video indefinitely by use of DVD archiving.

The report further details the number of stops resulting in arrest, citation, or both (3359), breaks down the race or ethnicity of drivers stopped, whether race or ethnicity was known prior to the stop, whether a search was conducted, and the number of searches that would be considered as consensual. No analysis of the data is required, and none is provided in the report.

The department received no racial profiling complaints in 2015.

The law requires no action on the part of city council regarding this report. However, I will be available to answer any questions they may have regarding it, or our reporting practices.

This Agency claims partial racial profiling report exemption because:

Our vehicles that conduct motor vehicle stops are equipped with video and audio equipment and we maintain videos for 90 days.

Certification to This Report 2.132 (Tier 1) – Partial Exemption

Article 2.132(b) CCP Law Enforcement Policy on Racial Profiling

SAGINAW POLICE DEPT. has adopted a detailed written policy on racial profiling. Our policy:

- (1) clearly defines acts constituting racial profiling;
- (2) strictly prohibits peace officers employed by the SAGINAW POLICE DEPT. from engaging in racial profiling;
- (3) implements a process by which an individual may file a complaint with the SAGINAW POLICE DEPT. if the individual believes that a peace officer employed by the SAGINAW POLICE DEPT. has engaged in racial profiling with respect to the individual;
- (4) provides public education relating to the agency's complaint process;
- (5) requires appropriate corrective action to be taken against a peace officer employed by the SAGINAW POLICE DEPT. who, after an investigation, is shown to have engaged in racial profiling in violation of the SAGINAW POLICE DEPT.'s policy adopted under this article;
- (6) require collection of information relating to motor vehicle stops in which a citation is issued and to arrests made as a result of those stops, including information relating to:
  - (A) the race or ethnicity of the individual detained;
  - (B) whether a search was conducted and, if so, whether the individual detained consented to the search; and

(C) whether the peace officer knew the race or ethnicity of the individual detained before detaining that individual; and

(7) require the chief administrator of the agency, regardless of whether the administrator is elected, employed, or appointed, to submit an annual report of the information collected under Subdivision (6) to:

(A) the Commission on Law Enforcement; and

(B) the governing body of each county or municipality served by the agency, if the agency is an agency of a county, municipality, or other political subdivision of the state.
