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SUBJECT: Consideration and Action regarding authorization of Proposed Food Truck Park and Farmers Market at Willow Creek Park

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

On July 17, 2018 the City Council received a briefing providing a conceptual overview of a proposed Food Truck Park and Farmers Market at the south end of Willow Creek Park. Based on the feedback received from the Council, staff proceeded to prepare a budget to construct the facility.

The budget is based on estimates from vendors and from Tarrant County who will construct the parking lot, loop road and access road. The scope of work includes the construction of two 40' x 50' pavilions with cedar accents, surfacing of the gathering area and the infield area of the loop road with crushed granite, LED lighting in the pavilions and gathering area, 400 amp service for the food trucks, asphalt loop road and 80 +/- space parking lot.

The total estimated cost with 10% contingencies is \$370,000.

Some minor work such as sidewalk relocation, grading and a driveway approach will be performed by city force account.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The total Financial Impact is a not to exceed amount of \$370,000. Funds are available in the General Fund Balance.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends City Council authorize the proposed Food Truck Park and Farmers Market for a not to exceed amount of \$370,000.
